



## Mountain Air

Mountain Air, based in Santa Fe, New Mexico, provided commuter airline service on an Albuquerque-Santa Fe-Denver route in 1974 and 1975 using Cessna 402 aircraft. Two daily round-trip flights were operated and a stop at Taos, New Mexico was added by the winter of 1974. In the spring of 1975, the carrier also added an Albuquerque-Santa Fe-Raton-Denver round trip. All flights began operating with Piper Navajo aircraft at this time with a Piper Seneca soon joining the fleet.
