Air Ruidoso

Air Ruidoso was a commuter airline based in Ruidoso, New Mexico. The company began operations on July 20, 1987 with flights from Ruidoso to Albuquerque and El Paso using Piper Navajo Chieftain aircraft. Service to Alamogordo was added on March 14, 1988 with flights to Albuquerque, El Paso, and Ruidoso however the company ceased operating in November 1988 after its F.A.A. certificate was revoked. During the time of Air Ruidoso's service, the carrier had switched from operating at the old Ruidoso Municipal Airport to the new Sierra Blanca Regional Airport serving the area beginning in December, 1987.
