

S. I. Airways

S. I. Airways was based in Denver, Colorado and served Raton, New Mexico in 1973 and 1974. During October, 1973 the carrier operated one daily roundtrip on a Denver-La Junta, Colorado-Raton-Amarillo route. At one point S. I. Airways operated Denver-La Junta-Trinidad-Raton also with one daily roundtrip. An eight passenger Cessna 402 aircraft was used. By 1975 the carrier had changed its name to Trans Mountain Air and was operating routes from Denver into Wyoming using Aero Commander aircraft.
