

Territorial Airlines

Territorial Airlines operated from June 18 through September 17, 1990 and was based out of the Santa Fe Cookie Company shop in Santa Fe, New Mexico. The carrier operated a Piper Navajo Chieftain aircraft with morning and late afternoon roundtrips on an Albuquerque-Las Vegas-Raton, Nexico route and a midday flight on an Albuquerque-Santa Fe-Roswell, New Mexico route. The service to Las Vegas and Raton was the first airline service these communities had seen in fifteen years and no other carrier has flown there since. Territorial's life was also very short, lasting for three months.
