

The Santa Fe Airline Company

The Santa Fe Airline Company was based in Santa Fe, New Mexico and provided commuter airline flights from Albuquerque to Santa Fe and Taos, New Mexico from late 1973 through late 1974. Up to seven daily roundtrip flights were operated between Albuquerque and Santa Fe plus one daily and up to five Saturday only flights to Taos during the winter ski season. The carrier used a single engine Cessna 206 and a multi-engine Aero Commander 500 aircraft.
