



Trans California Airlines

Trans California Airlines operated from December 19, 1980 through April 1981 and was based in El Monte, California, a suburb of Los Angeles. For a brief period in December 1980 the carrier published schedules in the Official Airline Guide on a route from Mesa, Arizona to Wichita, Kansas with stops at Phoenix, Sedona, Flagstaff, Gallup, Albuquerque, Santa Fe, Amarillo, Oklahoma City, and Wichita using Piper Navajo's. One daily flight (Monday through Friday) was scheduled in each direction. No evidence can be found if this route was actually flown.
