

Western Air Stages "Westair"

Western Air Stages, or "Westair", began operations in 1972 and was based in Grand Junction, Colorado. About June 1, 1976 the carrier replaced Frontier Airlines service at Cortez, Colorado and began a Farmington-Cortez-Grand Junction route using Douglas DC-3 aircraft. The service only lasted a few months when Westair ceased operations and Frontier returned to flying the route. A second Westair operated along the west coast as United Express in the 1980's and there in no known correlation between the two carriers.
