## Piper PA-18 or J-5 on private land in Sandia Mountains, NM

## HISTORY

There are the partial remains of an aircraft on private property in Bear Canyon east of Albuquerque, NM. Several crash explorers hiking to an A-17 crash site deeper into the wilderness have seen those remains, but have no history of the plane. In 2009, the AAHG was approached by a property owner representative for information about the remains. They were referred to the *Piper Aviation Museum* which was only able to ascertain from photographs that it was either that of a PA-18 Super Cub or a J-5 Cub. As of early 2013, there is no way to tell how old the remains are or whether it crashed nearby or was even brought to the present location for some unknown reason
