## Lynx Aviation

Lynx Aviation was founded in 2006 by Frontier Airlines Holdings to take over servicing some of the markets flown by Frontier Airlines within close proximately of the carriers' hub in Denver as well as beginning new service to smaller cities. A fleet of 74-seat DeHavilland DHC-8-Q400 aircraft was obtained and service from Albuquerque to Denver commenced on December 15, 2007. The Albuquerque service was suspended in 2008 in favor of operating all Frontier mainline jets but restarted in 2009. Lynx was later purchased by Republic Airways which then decided to go with an all-jet fleet and shut down the Lynx operation. The last service to Albuquerque was on July 14, 2011.
