



Ozark Air Lines (2000-2001)

A second Ozark Airlines began in 2000 by operating two, 32-seat, Fairchild Dornier 328 Jets on a Dallas/Ft. Worth-Columbia, Missouri-Chicago Midway route. This carrier was based in Columbia, Missouri and was not related to the original Ozark Airlines of 1950 through 1986. During the winter ski season of 2001 from January 7 through March, Ozark operated public charter flights on Thursdays and Sundays from Dallas/Ft. Worth to Taos, New Mexico with the Dornier 328 Jets. Ozark ceased operating later in 2001 and sold its assets and operating certificate to Great Plains Airlines. The DFW-Taos ski service was not reinstated.
