



## Angel Fire Airport

The Angel Fire Airport is a public use airport owned and operated by Colfax County and located two miles north of Angel Fire, New Mexico. The airport is one of the highest in the country at an altitude of 8,340 feet elevation. It sits in the Moreno valley with mountain peaks of 11,000 to 13,000 feet height on the east and west sides. The airport has one north-south runway of 8900 ft. length and can accommodate small jets.

Originally the single runway was a 6700 foot long dirt strip. It was paved in the early 1970's and lengthened to 8900 feet in the latter 1980's. During the winter ski season of 1986-1987, the airport saw commercial airline service by Mesa Airlines providing one flight per day to Albuquerque on a Beech 1900C aircraft.
