



Aztec Municipal Airport

The Aztec Municipal Airport is a general aviation airfield with two paved runways located two miles northwest of Aztec, New Mexico. The airport has very little activity however it is occasionally used as an alternate field for the nearby Four Corners Regional Airport located 13 miles to the southwest in Farmington, New Mexico. In October of 2021 while the Four Corners Airport was undergoing runway construction, several light cargo aircraft operating on behalf of FedEx and UPS used the Aztec airport instead. On a hazy day in the 1970's, a Frontier Airlines Convair 580 mistakenly landed at Aztec rather than Farmington as one of the runways at Aztec, 08-26, has the same heading as a runway in Farmington.
