

Sun Country Airlines

Sun Country, d/b/a MN Airlines, was established in 1982 and is based in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The carrier has scheduled commercial flights, public and private charters, and also flies cargo flights for Amazon Prime. Sun Country started operating with Boeing 727-200 and Douglas DC-10 aircraft but transformed to an all Boeing 737 fleet in the early 2000's, primarily the 737-800. The carrier has been serving Albuquerque since 2002 with regular public charters to Laughlin, Nevada in connection with Harrah's Laughlin Hotel Casino. Charter flights occasionally operate to Reno, Nevada as well. The flights operate every one to two months but are sometimes paused for extended periods of time. Sun Country also operates many charter flights at Albuquerque and Las Cruces for sporting events and other purposes. The carrier plans to begin scheduled flights between Albuquerque and Minneapolis on a summer seasonal basis beginning in the summer of 2024.
