

Via Air

Via Air operated gambling junket charter flights from Albuquerque to Laughlin, Nevada from the fall of 2015 through spring, 2016. The flights were in connection with Caesar's Entertainment Corporation using Embraer 120 Brasilia propeller aircraft and Embraer 145 regional jets. Via Air, operated by Charter Air Transport, was founded in 2014 and was based in Maitland, Florida. The carrier also operated scheduled flights from hubs at Austin, Texas, Charlotte, North Carolina, and Orlando, Florida in 2018 and 2019. Some scheduled flights were subsidized by the United States Government under the Essential Air Service (EAS) program. Via Air declared bankruptcy and ceased operations in October, 2019.
