10 Tanker Air Carrier is a company operating converted Douglas DC-10 aircraft to fight wildfires. The company was founded in 2003 in California and moved its base to the Albuquerque International Sunport in 2013. Four DC-10 tankers are normally stationed at the Sunport and regularly use the Roswell International Air Center for reloading of fuel and fire retardant as well. Extensive operations were flown throughout New Mexico fighting several very large wildfires during April through June, 2022.

Erickson Aero Tanker

Erickson Aero Tanker is a company using a fleet of converted McDonnell Douglas MD-87 aircraft to fight wildfires. Erickson Aero is based in Hillsboro, OR and normally stations at least one of its MD-87's at the Alamogordo White Sands Regional Airport. During April through June, 2022, five aircraft were stationed at ABQ to fight several large wildfires throughout New Mexico at the time. On June 18 and 19, 2024, Erickson made several runs from Alamogordo fighting a large fire near Ruidoso, NM. The MD-87's also fly into and out of the Grant County Airport serving Silver City, NM.

AeroFlite flew extensive operations throughout New Mexico during April through June, 2022 and in June, 2024. The Avro RJ-85's operated at the airports in Albuquerque, Alamogordo, and Silver City, New Mexico. The CL-415's flew mainly out of Santa Fe and Truth or Consequences, New Mexico scooping water from Heron and Elephant Butte reservoirs.
