Socorro Municipal Airport

The Socorro Municipal Airport is a general aviation airfield serving Socorro and Socorro County, New Mexico. It is located two miles south of the city of Socorro. It has two paved runways and can handle most types of light aircraft including small jets.

The airport briefly saw commercial airline service in the early 1950's when **Continental Airlines** landed their Douglas DC-3's at Socorro as one of many stops on a route between Denver and El Paso.
