

Sun Country Airlines

Sun Country is based at Minneapolis, Minnesota where it operates a hub with scheduled flights. The carrier also operates a high volume of public and private charters as well as cargo flights for Amazon Prime. Sun Country was established in 1982 and began operating with Boeing 727-200 and Douglas DC-10 aircraft but transformed to an all Boeing 737 fleet in the early 2000's, primarily the 737-800. The carrier has been serving Albuquerque since 2002 with regular public charters to Laughlin and Reno, Nevada. Sun Country also operates many charter flights to both Albuquerque and Las Cruces for sporting events and other purposes as well as Amazon Prime cargo flights to Albuquerque. The carrier began scheduled flights between Albuquerque and Minneapolis on a summer seasonal basis beginning with the summer of 2024. Sun Country will also schedule service to Minneapolis during the annual Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta in early October.
